### CHRISTMAS HAMPER PROGRAM

In conjunction with the Giving Tree, Food and Toys are distributed to those families who cannot afford a Christmas.

### COATS FOR KIDS CAMPAIGN

The Salvation Army works together with various community partners to make sure children stay warm in the winter. Donations are received in September and distributed in October.

### CHILDREN HOLIDAY & MOMS & TOTS CAMPS

18 spaces for children ages 7 to 17 years old on a first come first serve basis and 5

spaces for moms and tots ages 0-7 are reserved for underprivileged homes to attend adventure camps at Jackson's Point, ON and Newport Adventure Camp in Huntsville, ON.



### JUMP START

The cost of sports for outdoor and indoor programs plus equipment is high. To help families who live in Cobourg, Port Hope and some parts of Hamilton and Haldimand Townships, the Canadian Tire Foundation for Families provides funding (under certain guidelines) to help keep kids active.



## Emergency & Counselling

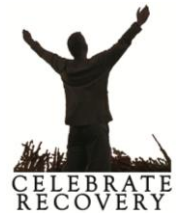
### (1) ONE ON ONE INTERVIEW
