COATS FOR KIDS CAMPAIGN

JUMP START

The cost of sports for outdoor and indoor programs plus equipment is high. To help families who live in Cobourg, Port Hope and some parts of Hamilton and Haldimand Townships, the Canadian Tire Foundation for Families provides funding (under certain guidelines) to help keep kids active.



Emergency & Counselling

(1) ONE ON ONE INTERVIEW

Through one-on-one interviews, individuals and families identifying hurts, habits or hang-ups can receive support or be referred to support.

(2) CELEBRATE RECOVERY

Tuesday Evening 6:30pm – 9:00pm.

(3) EMERGENCY HOUSING SERVICES – County Funded

Moving people from the streets into temporary shelter. Works with local shelters, Police services, motels and out of the area shelters.

(4) EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

For victims of small-scale disasters i.e. fire & motor vehicle accidents. We provide services that include food, accommodations, personal needs items, housing, clothing, appliances & household items.
